The standard of cricket in Division 1 was very high this season with some clubs fielding their top side others their second team. From the start of the year our team showed that we were title contenders and started the year with good wins. In round three I believe we grew together and became a close nit team after turning around a first innings loss to Lisarow and winning outright chasing 217 in 35 overs for the loss of only 3 wickets. This win was greatly attributed to strong bowling performances from Ethan MILNE and Tom MILOSTIC taking 6 wickets each in the game with the assistance of Tim KING 79 and Mickey WILLIAMS 84 n/o in the second innings. The win gave us a lot of confidence and we carried this throughout the year.
